I hereby release the **EQUESTRIAN CENTER OF WALNUT CREEK** (hereinafter referred to as the CORPORATION) and the **CITY OF WALNUT CREEK** (hereinafter referred to as the CITY) from all liability for any act of negligence or want of ordinary care on the part of the Corporation, and/or City or any of its agents. In consideration of my participation in events organized or sponsored by the

Corporation, I hereby waive, release, and discharge the Corporation and the City; their directors, officers, agents employees, and volunteers; their representatives, heirs, and executors; and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals, or my property arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon my executors, heirs, and assigns. I expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code 1542, which states: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditors do not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him, might materially affect his settlement with the debtor." I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless the Corporation and City; their officers, officials, directors, employees, agents and volunteers; against all claims, demands, and causes of actions, including court costs and actual attorney fees arising from any proceeding or lawsuits, brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld. I acknowledge that I have read this "Release of Liability" and understand its contents.

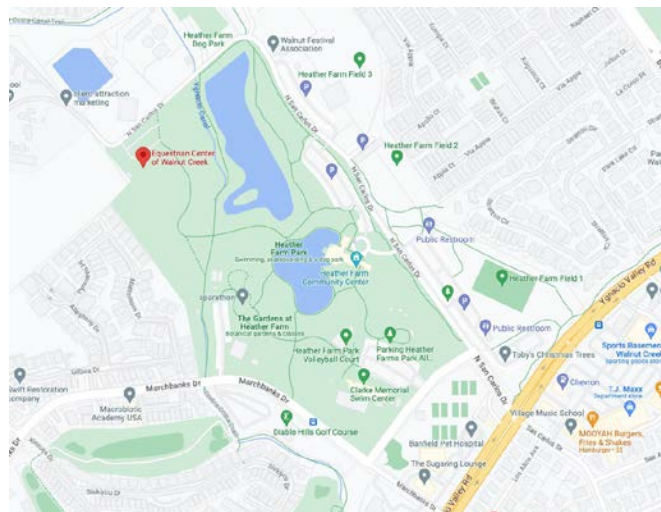


Equestrian Center of Walnut Creek English West Horse Show Rules & Information:

- CSHA & PAC Approved
- Judges to be determined
- West Coast Horse Show Rule Book to apply.
- The Main Arena (not including Trail course) will be open for schooling from 7:00am-8:00am. The Warm-up Arena will be open all day.
- ASTM/SEI approved helmets/headgear required for all English riders. Boots required for all riders. Hunt coats optional.
- Classes with fewer than 3 entries may be combined to judge, but will be separated for CSHA English Western Program divisions and daily High points.
- Awards for Classes: Prize to first place, ribbons first to sixth place.
- Awards for High Points: Awards and Tri-Color Ribbon to Champion, Tri-Color Ribbons to Reserve.
- Release of Liability must be signed by all persons riding or working with horses on the show grounds. Minors must have the signature of parent or guardian.
- **DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES**
- Refreshments and Lunch will be available for purchase on grounds.
- Must show ECWC or CSHA membership card, 4H Project report or Record book for proof of membership to qualify for pre-entry fees on the day of show.
- Add-ons welcome, advance refunds will not be given without a veterinarian certificate. Refunds day of show will be given if notice of scratch is given to registration/gatekeeper prior to class starting, refunds will be given at end of show.
- High Point Ties are decided by the number of first placings in equitation or trail. If neither of these settles the tie, then by coin toss.

DIRECTIONS - follow GPS to Heather Farm Park in Walnut Creek, CA:

From Ygnacio Valley Rd, turn onto N. San Carlos Drive. Follow N. San Carlos Drive past the soccer fields and ballparks. Please note there is parking available on the left for passenger cars, 5min walk to the Equestrian Center. Continue on N. San Carlos after a left turn past the large pond. The Equestrian Center will be past the dog park, the trailer entrance to the Equestrian Center will be on your left. After unloading, please park all other vehicles outside of the trailer parking area. Parking at the Equestrian Center is reserved for horse trailers, judges, volunteers and disabled.

- 1) You must pay a one-time \$10 registration fee.
- 2) You must compete in 3 out of 4 the shows to qualify for the Buckle Series.
 - 3) There shall be 6 buckle series award categories:

English 17 & Under	English 18 & Over
Western 17 & Under	Western 18 & Over
Ranch 17 & Under	Ranch 18 & Over
- 4) Each show establishes the classes that makeup these categories. These classes may vary from show to show. Refer to the individual show rules for further details.
- 5) Points are accrued based on a horse/rider combination and are not transferable to another combination.
- 6) The combination with the highest point totals of 3 out of 4 shows will be used to determine the Buckle Series champion.
- 7) There must be a minimum of 2 qualified combinations per category competing in order to receive the series award.
 - 8) Ties will be broken by random draw.
