Rules: We reserve the right to use a substitute or extra judge. Stallions are NOT allowed at the schooling show.

Dress: Neat, clean and proper for the class; boots, shirt with a collar are required. Chaps and coats are optional. ASTM approved helmets are to be worn with the chin strap securely fastened by all minors.

Western Bits: Mouthpiece of all bits will consist of a smooth metal bar 3/8" to 5/8" in diameter. Twisted or wire bits are only allowed in training classes. Hackamores, curb and snaffle bits are allowed in all Western classes. Tie down are allowed for training classes only. Prohibited: cavessons and wire chain straps.

English Bits: Regulation snaffles, Pelham, kimberwick and full bridles, all with cavessons. Prohibited: Martingales and figure 8 nosebands, except in training classes.

Optional: crops and spurs. Any humane training device is allowed at the discretion of the judge.

Schooling horses: Schooling horses are allowed in all classes. You must wear your number sideways and follow the directions of the class.

High Point: All classes are eligible for high point.

Returned Checks are subject to a \$25.00 fee.
