Corporation, I hereby waive, release, and discharge the Corporation and the City; their directors, officers, agents employees, and volunteers; their representatives, heirs, and executors; and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals, or my property arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon my executors, heirs, and assigns. I expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code 1542, which states: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditors do not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him, might materially affect his settlement with the debtor." I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless the Corporation and City; their officers, officials, directors, employees, agents and volunteers; against all claims, demands, and causes of actions, including court costs and actual attorney fees arising from any proceeding or lawsuits, brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld. I acknowledge that I have read this "Release of Liability" and understand its contents.

DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES

Classes \$10 a round or \$50 for the day

Schedule:

Starts at 9 am poles on the ground

Sand footing in a 300 by 150 foot arena

Courses will be posted at the gate or school for 2 minutes

DIRECTIONS:

From the South

Take 680 North towards Sacramento to the Ygnacio Valley Road exit.

Turn right onto Ygnacio Valley Road for about 2 miles.

Turn left onto N. San Carlos Drive.

Follow N. San Carlos Drive and it will make a turn to the left. The Equestrian Center will be on your left.

From the North

Take 680 South towards San Jose to the North Main Street exit.

Follow the exit around to the right onto North Main Street heading south.

Turn left onto Ygnacio Valley Road for about 2 miles.

Turn left onto N. San Carlos Drive. Follow N. San Carlos Drive and it will make a turn to the left. The Equestrian Center will be on your left.

From the West

Take 24 East towards Walnut Creek to the Ygnacio Valley Road exit.
